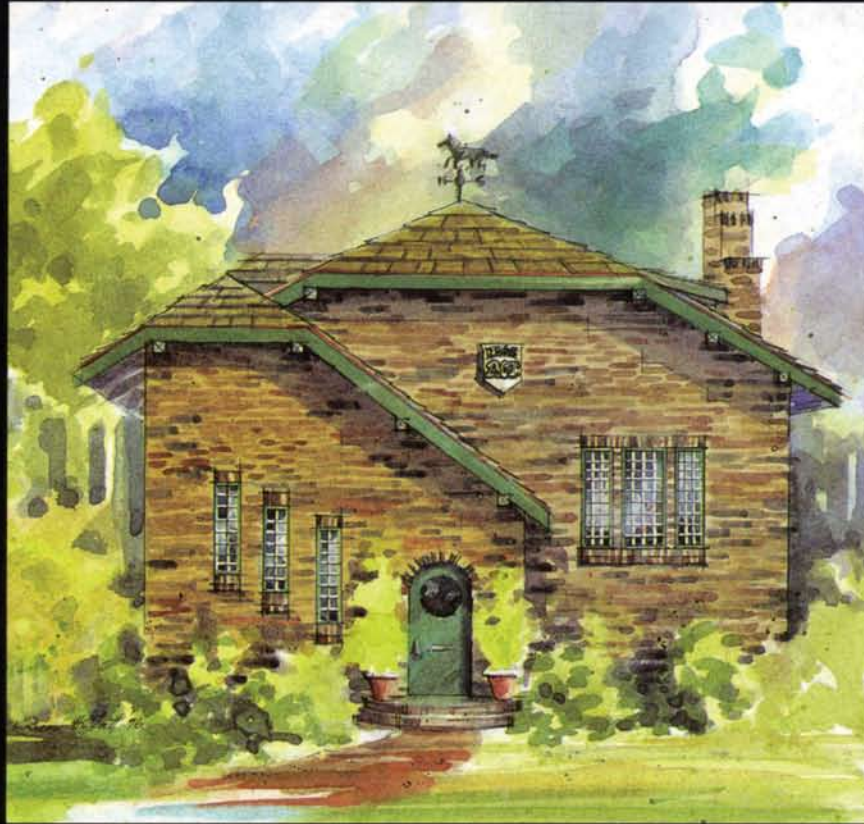

Shells, washed in from the sea, delight the senses and create the mood for the Main Bathroom. The designers have opened up and transformed the existing bathroom with innovative and creative design themes. Inlaid Marmoleum vinyl floor was installed, featuring the shell motif in three-colour neutral tones. A free-flowing faux design using the "sea" concept adorns the walls; a glass carved valance with the seashell motif wraps around the dropped ceiling area and adds a soft glow. Sound from a built-in audio system encourages a relaxing soak in the delightful claw-footed slipper tub; a pull on the nearby starfish knob reveals fluffy towels housed in the custom-milled vanity furniture. A two-tiered sculptured granite piece provides a grand support for the lovely sink; the stained glass window above is swagged in a fabric of shell designs. A wall-hung make-up unit from the Haus Couture architectural series adds a practical yet pretty finishing touch to this delightful space.
